## mus 174a - mic positions

- distance matters. close mics emphasize detail, highs, lows, transients. medium distance gives overall "picture" of instrument. greater distance emphasizes room and natural reverb.
- position of microphone influences what part of the instrument dominates the sound. other considerations: bass from floor reflection, noise from musician or instrument.
- multiple microphones are needed whenever more parts of the instrument are wanted or a bigger sound is desired. more bass, more space. 3:1 "rule".




Figure 3-1. Ideal Microphone Position

- angle can change the freq. response of the signal
- position of instrument as or more important than position of microphone
- overall spatial goal should be considered

## mus 174a - mic experiment...

- find a large space to record in
- perform from a spot about 2/3 across both room dimensions
- place mic 1 foot away, wear headphones while recording.
- move instrument or voice on axis and off, if instrument, move so mic picks up different parts of instrument. if instrument can't be moved, move mic.
- move closer and further from mic. try to find the best close sound and distant sound. make a doubled recording (same music, different position), close and distant.
